RESUMEN EJECUTIVO DE AUDITORÍA:

PGFS v3.2 audit, company Farmers El Fuerte SPR de RL - El Fuerte harvesting crew (01) Super sweet corn, with harvesting activity in sweet corn cultivation, on its own ranch called El Fuerte with an area of 314ha, with a cycle from May to August and destination market to Mexico, the United States and Canada. Harvesting is done manually and mechanically. Between 12 and 20 people participate. Manual harvesting consists of cutting the cob with the use of nitrile gloves, it is placed directly in plastic bins, with the support of 1 person inside the bins with the use of clean clothing and plastic shoe covers, another way is to place the cob on a mechanical belt, mounted to the tractor and by means of an escalator it falls into plastic bins. Likewise, it is harvested with mechanical equipment, mounted on the tractor, with the use of a mechanical cutter and 1 or 2 people directing the ears to the belt. The harvested product can be sent to the client in bulk or sent to an external handling center of the same company, receiving the product in plastic bins, placed with the support of forklifts on pallets, employees select according to quality and safety, cut the stem of the cob with the use of a stainless steel knife and plastic handle, it is placed in a rigid plastic box and later in a flexible polyethylene box, it goes to the hydration tunnel, using sprinklers, leaving a time of 3-5 minutes, using well water, treated with sodium hypochlorite at 1.5ppm. The boxes are identified with a traceability label, with data such as Julian day, year, farm, table, product and crew. Gloves and knives are washed with neutral soap and disinfected with sodium hypochlorite at 200ppm, using plastic buckets. The bins are transported on a metal trailer.
